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THE NATIONAL CURRICULUM AND TEXTBOOK BOARD

Introduction :

The National Curriculum and Text Book Board came into being as a result of the merger of the erstwhile Bangladesh School Text Book Board (which was established in 1954) and the National Curriculum Development Centre (which started functioning in January, 1981) on 2nd October, 1983. This institution is responsible for producing quality text books for the Primary and Secondary stages keeping in view the national educational needs. Since the production of quality text books is closely related to the preparation of curriculum in conformity with national educational policy, a closer linkage between the Text Book Wing and the Curriculum Wing of the amalgamated body will be helpful in attaining the goal.

Functions:

- 1. The broad functions of the National Curriculum and Text Book Board are as follows:
 - a. to examine curricula and syllabi of schools and suggest revision thereof.
 - b. to pre-test and evaluate the effectiveness of the curricula, syllabi and text-books of schools;
 - c. to arrange for the preparation of the manuscripts of the textbooks;
 - d. to arrange for the publication, distribution and sale of text-books;
 - e. to approve text-books, prize books, library and reference books;
 - f. to encourage scientific, literary and cultural works by providing grants and donations;
 - g. to donate books to the poor and deserving students;
 - h. to do such other acts and things as may be assigned to it by the Government from time to time.

 - a. Teachers of Schools, Colleges and Universities and literateurs;
 - b, Publishers, Printers, Binders and Block makers;
 - c. Book Sellers.

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
