### 3. The following experience & qualification is required:

#### (A) Financial Capability

- (i) The Tenderer must have minimum amount of liquid asset in the form of working capital or credit facility of BDT 25 million or USD 3,03,000 for each lot, regardless of size of the lot.
- (ii) The Tenderer's participating in multiple lots they must have cumulative financial capability for those lots.

### (B) Experience and Technical Capacity

#### (i) Experience:

The Tenderer shall have a minimum of 02 (Two) years of overall experience in the supply of goods and related services.

The minimum specific experience as Supplier in supply of similar Goods [Printing, Binding & Supplying of Books] of at least 02 (two) contracts successfully completed participating any tender within the last 05 (five) years, each with a value of at least Tk.1,00,00,000 (One crore). Last experience certificate from NCTB must be submitted.

Years counting backward from the date of publication of IFT in the newspaper.

- (ii) <u>Technical Capacity</u>: The minimum supply and/or production capacity of Goods is/are:
- (a) The Tenderer must have own sufficient machineries for Cover printing and 4 (four) colour Web printing machineries of Size 20"×30", Auto Glue binding machine and UV (Ultra varnish) laminating machine to execute the contract. If any sub-contractor appointed under GCC 15.2, its capacity also included into the technical capacity. Sub-contractor must have necessary machineries to execute the sub-contract.
- (b) The minimum production capacity of printing and Auto Glue binding machine of books shall be 100% in quantity of goods of proposed contract within 40 days and it will be verified before final evaluation.
- (c) A Printing Unit shall have a set of printing machineries along with all equipment (binding, UV lamination, cutting, bundling, etc machines) to furnish a set of complete books in the same premises of minimum 1000 sqft. Multiple Printing Units are acceptable considering the mentioned criteria. Address of all Printing Units must be mentioned in the tender and the printing and binding works must be done in that/those premises. Within the contract period Supplier/Manufacturer must not use this place for any other printing works.
- (d) Physical facilities of the tenderer shall be inspected by the TEC. Number of lot(s) to be awarded as per the capacity of the tenderer.

Production Capacity of the machinery is below:

The Production Capacity (including cover and text part) of the Machinery per day of four color Web Machine [only 20"×30" machine size will be considered] with capacity of 400 Reams.

Binding Capacity depends on clam. For each clam of an auto binding machine is 3000 books per day.

Tenderers participating in multiple lots must have cumulative experience and technical capacity for those lots

**Note:** For smooth production (printing, binding & supplying activities) in Primary and Secondary level, the production capacity of the machineries of the tenderer shall be aggregately calculated by the concern TEC under the HOPE of NCTB.

N.B: At the time of tender evaluation, occupied machine (by the concern TEC) shall not be considered for another tender (lots).
